4. **DESCRIPTION OF ELEMENTS INCLUDED IN THE ENTRY (GENERAL)**

Former Infants' and Girls' School - a single storey, semi-dressed stone building with tiled roof. In some places stonework is carved for decoration. Large windows accentuated by dressed stone surrounds. Central to the building and facing South Terrace is a small portico with a parapet roof. This signifies the main entrance.

This building is sited adjacent to the Fremantle Technical College (two storey building) which is included as a separate entry in the Register of Heritage Places.
