10. **STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE**

*Nungarin Roads Board Office (fmr)*, a single-room, single-storey timber framed and clad structure with a gable corrugated iron roof, in an inter-war rural Vernacular style, has cultural heritage significance for the following reasons:

the place is a rare surviving example of a single-room weatherboard road board office, simply designed in an inter-war Vernacular style; and,

the place is representative of the expansion of local government authorities across Western Australia during the inter-war years.
