10. **STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE**

*St Matthew's Church* has cultural heritage significance for the following reasons:

  - the building demonstrates the town's prosperity and importance within the colony in the 1870s;
  - the siting of the building is closely associated with the setting aside of Stirling Square for public purposes;
  - it is an important landmark set within Stirling Square; and
  - it is a fine example of Victorian ecclesiastical parish architecture.

The cultural significance of the Rectory (1930) has not been assessed at this time.
