10. STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

St Matthew's Church has cultural heritage significance for the following reasons:

the building demonstrates the town's prosperity and importance within the colony in the 1870s;

the siting of the building is closely associated with the setting aside of Stirling Square for public purposes;

it is an important landmark set within Stirling Square; and

it is a fine example of Victorian ecclesiastical parish architecture.

The cultural significance of the Rectory (1930) has not been assessed at this time.
