10. STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Alma School, has cultural heritage significance for the following reasons:

the place has a high social value for the local community who purchased the place, in 1956, and have maintained and restored it since that time as a social venue, and as a place to commemorate people associated with the educational and social activities of Alma for nearly eighty years;

the place contributes to the sense of place and historical identity in the community; and,

the place illustrates the provision of educational services to the Mid-West region of Western Australia in the first half of the twentieth century.
