10. **STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE**
Norlup Homestead, a Victorian Georgian single-storey clay brick and corrugated Colorbond roof homestead and its setting, has cultural heritage significance for the following reasons:
 - the place was constructed for the first European settlers in the district;
 - it is representative of Victorian Georgian rural homesteads;
 - the place is esteemed by the local community as a part of their heritage and for its associations with the first European settlers in the district; and,

the homestead, trees and garden setting located above Gnowongerup Brook contribute to the aesthetic qualities of the landscape.

Out buildings and farm sheds outside the homestead garden were not assessed.
