10. STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE
MacPherson Homestead has cultural heritage significance for the following reasons:

the place has a close association with the MacPherson family, early settlers who played an important and successful role in the development and growth of the Carnamah district;

the place is highly valued by the community as a reminder of the early European settlement of the district; and,

the place has particular structural interest, with its high walls and steeply pitched roof, and is a good example of a rural, vernacular Western Australian homestead of the 1870s.
