10. **STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE**

*St Catherine's Anglican Church*, a single-storey stone structure designed in the Federation Gothic style, has cultural heritage significance for the following reasons:

the place is an integral component of the Historic Greenough Hamlet, a small hamlet of national significance and has close associations with those families who played a major part in its development;

the place is a well executed example of a stone church in the Federation Gothic style and is representative of community churches that were built throughout Western Australia at that time; and,

the place represents the development of the Anglican community in Greenough.
