10. **STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE**  
*Kellerberrin Post Office and Residence* has cultural heritage significance for the following reasons:
  - the post office is the most impressive building in the town, and as such it makes an important contribution to the townscape of Kellerberrin;
  - the place is a fine example of Federation Free Style, exhibiting an individual style uncommon at the time;
  - the place represents the development of telecommunication services in the State in the early 1900s; and
  - the attached residence is a demonstration of a particular way of life of the postmaster in the first half of the twentieth century.
