10. **STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE**
Oakabella, comprising: homestead and associated walled garden and trees; a kitchen and quarters; two storey barn; blacksmith's shop (ruin); stables; shearing shed; and two framed houses with various modern light-framed shelter structures, has cultural heritage significance for the following reasons:

the place has aesthetic value as a unified group of farm buildings set in the landscape;

the place is representative of a phase of agricultural development of the State and the Northampton District;
