10. **STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE**
St. John the Baptist Anglican Church, a Victorian Gothic style church built in limestone and rendered, has cultural heritage significance for the following reasons:
 - the place is a landmark feature in the town of Dongara and makes a significant contribution to the historic and aesthetic character of the Dongara townscape;
 - the place is the sole known example of a church by significant colonial architect Francis Bird;
 - the place is very highly valued by the Anglican community and wider community for its historic, social, cultural and religious

associations and, as a result, contributes to these communities' sense of identity and place.
