3. **DESCRIPTION OF ELEMENTS INCLUDED IN THE ENTRY (GENERAL)**

Designed by Pietro Porcelli in 1911 to commemorate the life and work of C Y O'Connor in the fields of railways, harbour development and goldfields water supply, this bronze statue of O'Connor is mounted on a granite pedestal.
