10. **STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE**

*Edna May Tavern, Westonia*, a relocated single-storey timber and corrugated iron building, has cultural heritage significance for the following reasons:

the place is rare as a single-storey timber-framed hotel in Western Australia, unique as such in the Wheatbelt, and probably unique in Western Australia as a functioning relocated timber-framed hotel; and,

the place is significant for its construction during a gold boom in Western Australia, and as a remnant of that era.
