STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE **10**.

City Markets has cultural heritage significance for the following reasons:

The City Markets in Kalgoorlie has considerable historical and social significance, being a rare example of an architecturally designed market building in Western Australia. Owned and operated by the city council, it demonstrates the range of services a progressive local government expected to provide its ratepayers. Prominently located in Hannan Street, the market building is a strong reminder of Kalgoorlie's rapid growth during the turn of the century gold boom. continued use of the building as a markets adds to its significance as a reminder of a time when the buying and selling of fresh produce was not solely the province of the retail store.
