10. **STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE**

Sun Picture Gardens, a single-storey three sided timber framed structure clad with corrugated iron with a high twin-peaked roof, has cultural heritage significance for the following reasons:

the place is a rare example of a purpose built picture garden still in commercial operation. It is one of the oldest operating picture gardens in Australia;

the place is an integral and distinctive part of Broome's social life, contributing greatly to the community's sense of place and identity;

the building contributes to the streetscape which is enhanced by its building form and use of corrugated iron, both dominant streetscape characteristics; and,

the place is representative of the type of construction designed to suit the climatic conditions of the tropics as evidenced by its high-pitched roof and raised timber floor.
