10. **STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE**  
*Geraldton Town Hall (fmr)*, a two-storey Federation Academic Classical style rendered brick public building, has cultural heritage significance for the following reasons:
  - the place represents the development of civic life in Geraldton;
  - the place demonstrates the confidence experienced during the gold boom period of the state;
  - the place is a fine example of Federation Academic Classical architectural style, designed by Oldham and Cox;
