10. **STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE**

Masonic Lodge (fmr), Meekatharra, a single-storey timber-framed corrugated iron clad building erected in 1915, in vernacular style, has cultural heritage significance for the following reasons:

the place makes a significant contribution to the historic Goldfields townscape, through the scale and proportion of the simple, but fine and intact, building, including its interior, and adaptive use of lightweight materials in a remote location;

the place contains a fine and intact interior, in particular the Hall has an elaborate ceiling and simpler pressed metal walls; and,

the place is associated with the history of Freemasonry in Western Australia, especially in remote areas of the State.
