10. **STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE**

Chittering Road Board Office (fmr), a laterite and corrugated iron building in the Inter War Free Classical style, has cultural heritage significance for the following reasons;

the place is a fine example of an Inter War Free Classical style civic building with classical elements, constructed of distinctive, randomly laid, local laterite;

the place is rare as a governmental office and administration building constructed of laterite;

the place is indicative of the early growth and prosperity of Chittering and surrounding districts in the 1920s and is a prominent built element in an otherwise rural setting on Great Northern Highway in Chittering,; and,

the place is an excellent representative example of a 1920s rural road board office.

The works depot (c.1951), the foreman's dwelling (fmr) (1957) and the transportable accommodation are of little heritage significance.
