10. **STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE**
Trefusis, Chapman & Jose Factory (fmr), a single storey random limestone and corrugated iron factory with extensive stone collar constructed in 1886 in the vernacular, has cultural heritage significance for the following reasons:

the place was the largest aerated water factory in Western Australia when constructed incorporating many innovative technological

features, and is one of a few remaining examples of an aerated water factory in the State;

the place is a distinctive random limestone construction in the vernacular style, which makes a significant contribution to the streetscape and character of Geraldton's historic port environment;

the place is rare as a stone factory building in Western Australia; and

the place supplied both local and Perth markets with international award winning aerated water, cordials and syrups from 1875 until 1970, and was one of a number of soft drink and cordial manufacturers which thrived in the early twentieth century, prior to the domination of the market by multinational companies.

The toilet block, located at the north east corner of the site, has low significance.
