10. **STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE**
Coolgardie Post Office and Assoc. Buildings has cultural heritage significance for the following reasons:

The form, scale and massing of the building demonstrates the architectural skills of George Temple-Poole. The building helps to define the historic character of Coolgardie's main street. The building strongly contributes to the sense of identity of Coolgardie; a key town in the development of gold mining in Western Australia in the 1890s.
