10. **STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE**
Applecross Primary School (original buildings), a single storey weatherboard and corrugated iron school room with adjacent weatherboard and iron teacher's house, has cultural heritage significance for the following:
 - the place was the first purpose-built primary school in Applecross;
 - the school room is a typical one-teacher weatherboard school room of its period;
 - the place is closely associated with the establishment, growth and consolidation of educational services in the Applecross area; and,
 - the place has social value to both past pupils and present residents of Applecross because it demonstrates aspects of the past way of life of students in the suburb.
