10. **STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE**
Bunbury Railway Station (fmr), a single-storey brick structure with
corrugated steel roof cladding, has cultural heritage significance for the
following reasons:
 - it is a place of community interaction and identification;
 - it has intrinsic merit as a work of design and contributes to the city's
townscape; and,
 - it demonstrates the history of the planning and development of the
City of Bunbury and of the State's railway networks.

The landscaped grounds to the east and the bus and other vehicle parking areas to the west of the station building complex have little heritage significance.
