10. **STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE**
York Town Hall, comprising a brick and iron roofed building with elaborate stucco detailing, has cultural heritage significance for the following reasons:
 the place is a nationally recognised landmark;
 the highly individual treatment of the corner entry of *York Town Hall*, and its associated facades and interiors is a demonstration of creative and design excellence in the Federation Free Classical style, and

the place contributes to the community's sense of place through its aesthetic characteristics, civic functions, and historic and social associations.

The temporary office, built in 1995, in the main hall is considered to be intrusive in a space of considerable significance.
