10. STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Ocean View, a single-storey Victorian Regency style, stone residence with a galvanised iron roof and outbuilding, has cultural heritage significance for the following reasons:

the place is a residence of imposing scale which adds significantly to the landscape and contributes to the local community's sense of place;

the place is an example of a substantial dwelling built in a semi-rural area in the second half of the nineteenth century;

the place has close associations with Elias Solomon, an influential figure in the public and business life of Fremantle and in the

Western Australian Jewish community in the latter half of the nineteenth century; and,

the place is important for service as a military hospital during World War One, then as a maternity hospital during the inter-war years.
