10. STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Donegan's Cottage, a turn-of-the-century mud-walled house, has cultural heritage significance for the following reasons:

the place is a very simple example of a vernacular 'worker's cottage' built at the turn of the century and adapted to the needs and resources of a local family;

the place has a landmark quality in Toodyay and thus contributes to the community's sense of place;

the place is one of only a few early 'working class' residences remaining in Toodyay, and was occupied continuously by a family with a long work history in the town; and,

the place holds significant social value for the Toodyay community.
